LATE ATTENDANCE

The Course Provider must when booking a client onto Modules 1 & 2 of the 'TILE' course, inform the client that if he/she is more than 15 minutes late from the scheduled start time, that he/she will not be allowed to participate on that course and will be rebooked onto another course. This will apply to both modules. However, the time may be extended to 30 minutes, providing that the student has notified the Course Provider, stating a valid reason for being later.

MARKING AND SCORING OF THE EXAM

The Course Provider will mark each section of exam in Module 1 as follows:

- Give Way Diagrams, this part of the exam is compulsory and must be 100% correct.
- Section 1 (Road Law) minimum score 16 correct answers out of 22 questions.
- Section 2 (Logbook) minimum score 4 correct answers out of 6 questions.
- Section 3 (Axle Weights) minimum score 4 correct answers out of 6 questions.

To record a pass in 'Module 1' the student must achieve at least the minimum score in each section as listed above.

If the student is unsuccessful in only one section of the exam, the student must be given a supplementary exam paper and resit that section only. If the student is unsuccessful with the supplementary exam, the student must be rebooked onto another 'TILE Course' and resit the whole exam again.

If the student is unsuccessful in two sections of the exam, the student must be given a supplementary exam paper and resit the whole exam again. If the student is unsuccessful with the supplementary exam, the student must be rebooked onto another 'TILE Course' and resit the whole exam again.

If the student is unsuccessful in all sections of the exam, consideration must be given to rebooking the client onto another 'TILE Course'.

NOTE:

1. Once the exam has started the Course Provider must not discuss with the students any part of the exam, unless it is to clarify a question.
2. If, after marking the exam, it is found that a student will be required to resit part of or all of the exam again, the Course Provider may conduct further training before a supplementary exam is given. Once the exam has started the Course Provider must not discuss with the students any part of the exam, unless it is to clarify a question.
